Announcing the Seattle Worldcon 2025 Short Story Writing Contest!

Seattle Worldcon 2025 is excited to announce that we are holding a short story writing contest with adult and young adult entry categories. The winners in each category will be recognized at the convention, receive free memberships to the convention, and have their stories published in an upcoming anthology by Grim Oak Press. Stories must draw inspiration from our Worldcon theme: [Building Yesterday's Future—For Everyone](#). This theme was selected to invoke nostalgia for the hopeful science-fictional era of the early 1960s, when Seattle held its first (and until now, only) Worldcon, followed up by the Century 21 Exposition (a.k.a. 1962 World's Fair), showing the world a vision of its technological future, complete with freshly built Monorail and Space Needle.



Submissions will be open **January 5–20, 2025**. The submission must be a standalone, short fiction story.

Prizes will include a membership to Seattle Worldcon 2025 for the winners (and for the guardian of the YA winner) as well as publication in a forthcoming anthology by [Grim Oak Press](#).

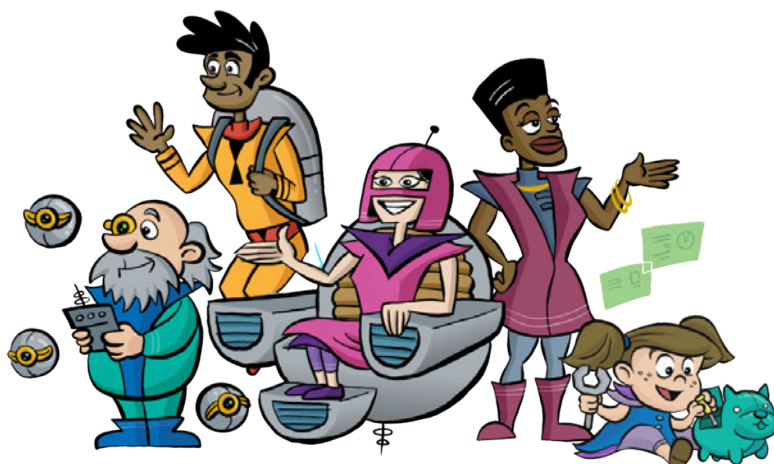
