

Quick Start Guide—How to Bid on Art

Items displayed on panels and tables may be available to bid on, purchase right now (Quick Sale), or are not-for-sale (NFS).

To **bid** on an item, write down your badge number and bid amount on the bid tag. Whole dollar increments only.

You **cannot** purchase an item for the Quick Sale price if a bid has already been made.

Some items are only available at the Quick Sale price. They have a minimum bid price one penny less than the Quick Sale price and bidding lines will be blacked out.

A bid is a promise to purchase: keep an eye on the items you bid on to see if someone else bids or if you are the only one.

Bidding ends at 6pm on Saturday. Check on Sunday morning starting at 10am to see if your bid was the last bid.

If you are the last bid on an item, it's yours! Find a staff member on Sunday to purchase.

Quick Start Guide—How to Buy Art

Purchase a Quick Sale item: Ask a staff member to come with you to the piece you want. Retrieve the bid tag, take it to an art show register and purchase. Pick up your item on Sunday at 10am by showing your receipt to a staff member. If you need to leave earlier, talk to the art show manager about pick up on a different day.

On Sunday, items are only available at the Quick Sale price unless a bid was made.

Purchase an item you bid on (and won): On Sunday starting at 10am, ask a staff member to come with you to the piece you won. Confirm your bid was the winning bid, head to an art show register, purchase, and take home!

Purchase a Print Shop item: Select the item(s) you want and take them directly to an art show register. Purchase and take with you the same day.
