"+"The Expanse is a wildly popular series that spawned 9 novels, 15 shorter works, & 6 seasons of excellent TV. What about this epic & characters made for such a hugely compelling experience? What impact did it have on SF, & what to watch next?"

Who *The Villains* [a character whose evil actions or motives are important to the plot] are depends on your POV. Who are YOUR 'favorite' Villains, and Why? Most Evil? Most misunderstood? Most fun to Cosplay? Bob's picks: Worst= Mao 1st 3 seasons, Duarte after; 'Favorite' = Amos; Most-misunderstood = Cortazar.

My candidates, in the show's order of appearance: (truly evil in Red, major assholes in yellow highlights)

- 1. **Joe Miller**, a Star Helix Detective at the start, taking bribes & his casual killing style could be described as villainous.
- 2. Vargas, 2-bit criminal that pays bribes to not change the air filters of his tenants, leading to preventable injuries.
- 3. Captain Shaddid, OK with kidnapping, murder, covers up Miller's Protogen Phoebe evidence, & fires Miller.
 - a. Still running Ceres' security in book 6.
- 4. **Jim Holden**, reckless transmission of incomplete data leads to a lot of deaths & goes full 'Miller' in the 2nd book.
 - a. Roci kills >12 anti-pirate kills in book 2 & Holden somehow believes they had only remaining Protomolecule.
- 5. Amos Burton, LOTS of bad behavior in past & in the series, but is it forgiven due to his completely skewed morality?
- 6. Executive Officer, does his obvious insanity forgive him shooting a gun in his Ice Trawler Canterbury cabin?
- 7. **Chrisjen Avasarala**, uses gravity torture on belters at start; drives Franklin Degraaf to suicide seeking Mars INTEL; blackmails Carlos Davila by threatening to keep his son, Esteban, in jail; & releases classified data for political gain.
- 8. **Heikki Sobong**, OPA terrorist involved in smuggling stealth tech.
- 9. Jules-Pierre Mao, mastermind behind the entire murderous series of events starting The Expanse.
- 10. Sadavir Errinwright, UN Undersec-Gen until Avasarala provides proof of his treason with Mao; murders Korshunov.
 - a. Much later, in #3, he's Lunar Supermax Penal Facility inmate 12-03-7154 & gets visit from son, Jefferson.
- 11. Diogo, minor Ceres water-stealing criminal later used by Dawes as a diversion to help steal Cortazar.
- 12. Anderson Dawes, OPA leader on Ceres and system-wide crime lord, dealing in piracy, drugs, terrorism, etc.
- 13. Pock Mark (or Filat Kothari), Loca Greiga thug who spears Dimitri Havelock in the Rosse Buurt (Ceres Red Light district).
- 14. Col Frederick Lucius Johnson, the UNN Marine "Butcher of Anderson Station" & 10 years later an OPA Leader.
- 15. Gero, Anderson Station dissident: 'We should've dumped a few more bosmain into space, when we had the chance.'
- 16. Thug #1 Lida, ½ of Dawes' OPA team that abducts, tortures, & attempts to throw Miller out a Ceres' airlock.
- 17. Thug #2 Kaipo, ½ of Dawes' OPA team that abducts, tortures, & attempts to throw Miller out a Ceres' airlock.
- 18. Uncle Mateo, frustrated Belter miner, that suicide runs a load of rocks into a MCRN Scipio Africanus patrol ship.
- 19. Bug Eyes, abusive MCRN dude from Scipio Africanus patrol ship that pushes Uncle Mateo over the edge.
- 20. Kenzo, Carlos Davila's corporate spy OK with leading Holden & crew to a lethal trap at Blue Falcon Hotel.
- 21. Larissa Stadnichuk (actress name) & other 3 of Black Ops execution team.
- 22. 'Woman' on Anubis & all other Mao assassins, willing to murder & start a war without hesitation.
- 23. Antony Dresden & all amoral Protogen scientists willing to sacrifice ANY number of people to get what they want.
- 24. Nikil, OPA Black Sky operative that planted the shuttle bomb trying to assassinate Avasarala. Johnson spaces him.

- 25. Secretary General Sorrento-Gillis, the stereotypical politician, willing to sacrifice millions for his own gain.
- 26. Admiral Nguyen, in league with Errinwright, tries to commit genocide on Mars.
- 27. Cotyar, Avasarala's hired special ops spy. No hesitation to kill in cold blood (Theo from Guanshiyin).
- 28. Camina Drummer, Johnson's 2nd in Command, OPA pirate with flexible morals, & President of the Transport Union.
- 29. Paolo Cortazar, last of Thoth station brain-altered Nanoinformatics, goes on to run 'the pit' on Laconia. {misunderstood?}
- 30. **S2, Roberta 'Bobbie' W. Draper**, only considered a villain by those she has to fight, trying to do what's right.
- 31. Surly Belter Crewman, & all others that deliberately space all 'Inners' on "Ganymede Refugee Ship".
- 32. Captain Martens, MCRN chaplain OK with sacrificing Marine squads to test Hybrid soldier (Project Caliban field test).
- 33. Staz & Edin, OPA thugs that decide to lead a violent overthrow of Johnson on Tycho, including murder in cold-blood.
- 34. Dr. Lawrence Strickland, revels in sacrificing children & turning them into Protomolecule soldiers.
- 35. Lydia Maalouf Allen, substitute mother & lover to Amos, who was a Baltimore criminal as well.
- 36. Pyotr Korshunov, Martian Minister of Defense that's OK with sacrificing Marine squads to test Protomolecule Tech.
- 37. Head Cop, Flunky Cop, & Stunt Cop #3, Ganymede thugs trying to steal The Weeping Somnambulist.
- 38. Roma, Ganymede thug exploiting the disaster to take advantage of desperate survivors.
- 39. Umea, just as morally bankrupt as her boss, Strickland, sacrificing children & turning them into Bioweapons.
- 40. Captain Malik, JPM Bodyguard, & all Mao's murderous thugs on the Guanshiyin (Mao's yacht).
- 41. **S3**, **Pilot**, another of Mao's murderous thugs on the Guanshiyin (Mao's yacht).
- 42. Medical Tech, just as morally bankrupt as her boss on Io, Strickland, converting children into Bioweapons.
- 43. Katoa, under protomolecule's guidance, dismantling a Medical Tech with his bare hands.
- 44. Lt. Boyer, stereotypical "I was just following orders" stooge of Admiral Nguyen.
- 45. Evita Jung, the heartless harlot that broke the heart of desperate slingshot pilot, Maneo Jung-Espanoza.
- 46. Videographer Elio 'Cohen' Casti, paid to sabotage the Rocinante without knowing WTF he's doing.
- 47. Belter #1 (Dealer), selling drugs to workers on the O.P.A.S. BEHEMOTH, leading to death of the Buyer.
- 48. Commander Klaes Ashford, OPA pirate who makes some bad bull-headed decisions almost wiping out humanity.
- 49. Clarissa Mao (Melba Koh), hell-bent of revenge against Holden for her father, using murder of friends & terrorism.
- 50. **S4, Dr. Lucia Mazur**, *Ilus* settler driven by desperation to plant explosives that kill 23 trying to land there.
- 51. Leelee, small criminal with no qualms about deaths or consequences of their activities.
- 52. **Belter Pirate**, just another thug ready to prey on the desperately vulnerable colonists.
- 53. Chief Adolphus Murtry, sociopathic/sadistic RCE-corp security chief that justifies & enjoys cold-blooded murder.
- 54. Chandra Wei, RCE security guard foolish enough to follow Murtry even to the point of being willing to shoot Amos.
- 55. **Scotty**, *Ilus* settler happy to kill Earthers in shuttle and shoot anyone that tries to remove them.
- 56. Coop, Ilus settler happy to kill Earthers in shuttle and provokes Murtry until he gets shot dead.
- 57. David Draper, teenager duped into making "focus drugs" for Martian Cop & low-level Crime boss, Esai.
- 58. Detective Esai Martin, Martian Cop & low-level Crime boss with flexible morals beyond his family life.
- 59. **Kellan**, *Ilus* settler happy to kill Earthers in shuttle and shoot anyone that tries to remove them.
- 60. **Dock Foreman**, wants Bobbie to continue criminal salvage as long as he gets a cut & turns Bobbie in when she quits.
- 61. Marco Inaros, pawn of Admiral Duarte happy to bomb billions of Earthers to death & many other crimes. (Bob's least)
- 62. Black Sky Leader, Primo Arriaga, Segundo Arriaga, Matar Kibileya Leader, & Golden Bough Leader (OPA).
- 63. Angeletti, Ilus settler desperate enough to lead others to take RCE guards hostage.
- 64. Fence & Shady Dude, wanted to cheat Esai from payment for latest crime S4 E4, but Bobbie intervened.
- 65. **Beltran**, just another expendable ex-MCRN criminal in Duarte's web of treason.
- 66. **Security Officer**, on the *Edward Israel*, who implements **Murtry**'s shuttle bomb vs the *Rocinante*.
- 67. Arum Lee, just another expendable ex-MCRN supply officer criminal in Duarte's web of treason.
- 68. Filip Inaros, willingly follows psychopathic dad almost until the very end, including mass murder.
 - a. His defection from Free Navy much better in book 6, with him staying behind on Callisto as Fillip Nagata.
- 69. **55**, Karal, asshole Marcos follower, happy to murder & do anything in her fanatical devotion.
- 70. Cyn, old Marcos follower, does almost anything he says, even hiding baby Filip from Naomi.
- 71. Andrew, just another expendable Marcos follower, dies while taking out the U.N.S. Hasami, science ship near Venus.
- 72. Sakai, Tycho chief engineer working to sabotage the *Rocinante*, shoot **Fred Johnson** in back, & aide in mass murder.

- 73. Flunky Thug, Boss Thug +2 on the *The Lazy Songbird*, Belter Ferry, En Route to Luna, cross Amos in a bad mood.
- 74. Arms Trader, selling Martian Power Armor on black market.
- 75. **UN Admiral Delgado**, wasn't going to list him originally, but he gives the worst advice to **Paster**, like nuking Pallas.
- 76. Belter Pirate Captain, just a pirate that attacks the Sulaiman Al Mahri colonist ship too close to Drummer's crew.
- 77. **Theo**, minor thug in Erich's crime organization.
- 78. Admiral Sauveterre, major MCRN officer black marketeer in Duarte's web of treason.
- 79. Lt. Emily Babbage, minor MCRN officer black marketeer and Admiral Sauveterre's spy in Duarte's web of treason.
- 80. Erich, major Baltimore crime boss and all his organization's thugs.
- 81. Dock Tough, minor Baltimore thug that's lucky he & his 3 buddies walked away from Amos.
- 82. Galip & Rattana, two minor Pallas bums that try to shake down Naomi.
- 83. Tamir & Vedasto Duru, 2 kidnappers of journalist Monica Stuart, also killed as expendable accessories.
- 84. Woman in Hotel, & male other former MCRN petty officer assassin sent to kill Alex Kamal on Sauveterre's orders.
- 85. Konecheck, psychopathic augmented-strength murderer.
- 86. Survivalist, attempted to kill Amos after striking a 'deal' with him, but Clarissa sweeps in at hyper-speed to kill him.
- 87. **Pella Crew #1** & **#2**, just more expendable **Marcos** followers.
- 88. David Paster, not really a 'Villain'; just basically unfit to be UNN Secretary General & accepts bad advice.
- 89. **Hutch**, one of **Erich**'s better lieutenants.
- 90. Pinkwater Leader of ex-security thugs that mistakenly try to shake down Erich's gang at Lake Winnipesaukee.
- 91. S6, Rosenfeld Guoliang, Marcos' right-hand, willing to do ANYthing, even mass murder of Ceres' Belters.
- 92. Yoan, Filip's foolish "Free Navy" big-mouthed thug-buddy, right up to the moment Filip shoots him dead.
- 93. **Liang Walker**, & his right-hand **Corrido**, Golden Bough pirates, who opportunistically ally with **Drummer**.
- 94. Admiral Duarte, mastermind of the MCRN defection to Laconia, Marcos' puppet master, & mass murderer. {Bob's #1}
- 95. **Tadeo**, just another expendable **Marcos'** follower, even setting the bombs on Ceres that end up killing his brother.
- 96. I DON'T include any of the following as 'Villains', since they're all beyond our human definition of that word.
 - a. The Protomolecule, just a tool following its programming, no real agency beyond its pre-determined goals.
 - b. The Builders, just expanding their collective civilization long before anything sentient existed on Earth.
 - c. "The Goths", just pissed off extra-dimensional entities trying to stop invaders messing with their universe.
 - i. This term is coined by **Teresa Duarte** in book 8.

- 11. Captain Thorsson, handles Bobbie's debriefing after Ganymede attack & "doesn't care if it kills her" to wake her.
- 12. **General Adiki-Sandoval**, exact role within UNN conspiracy was unclear.
- 13. Soren Cottwald, Chrisjen Avasarala's traitorous secretary that undermines her efforts until caught by Bobbie.
- 14. Mr. Vedas, Ganymede "customs inspector" + 2 thugs that try to shake down Holden's crew on
- 15. Wendell, Martian ex-Pinkerton security on Ganymede that gets hired by Holden instead of shaking him down.
 - a. +5 of his team: Paula, 'older-guy', Guthrie, Caudel (dies), & Uchi.
- 16. Foster, Chrisjen Avasarala's bribable Com-Tech who handles encryption for Admiral Nguyen.
- 17. Ameer, Intel guy for Chrisjen Avasarala in Atlanta.

- 18. Ferguson, Mott, Sergeant Chernev + at least a dozen other unnamed of UNN Covert Ops Ganymede strike team.
- 19. Amanda Telele, Soren Cottwald's fake name for Bobbie as a 'free operative of the Martian Intelligence Service.'

 - i. The SUPER efficient "recyclers", which all food leftovers, utensils, clothes, etc. get put into are very problematic, but given 2 centuries & the extreme need, then *maybe* they might be possible?
 - b. Everything else about the show, from the visuals to the ship travel times, is Technologically Spot On!
 - i. For me, it's The Expanse's scientific accuracy that makes my "Inner Engineer" VERY HAPPY!
 - ii. Finally, a show that gets space acceleration right & need to flip-&-burn half-way to slow back down!
 - iii. Examples of extreme detail include the retro-engines on all PDCs to counteract the gun's recoil.
 - c. The depth of the believable characters is also excellent, with story lines that make sense, and interactions and development that makes the audience actually care about them.
 - d. Epic story arcs embracing humanity's future told in a way that doesn't insult the viewer's intelligence.
 - e. The world-building is 1st rate. The geopolitics, cultures, and norms are there for you to absorb if you want to, but not spoon-fed to the audience as if every aspect of daily life needs to be explicitly spoken out loud.
 - f. No show is perfect: S2E1, no way 5 Martian torps fly right next to an UNN BB w/o PDCs being fired at them!
 - i. S3E10, NO way that Naomi or Clarissa would have ANY chance of reaching the Roci before Martians!
 - ii. S5E5, Razorback does Emergency Core Dump fleeing from Free Navy, how does it have engine in E6?!
 - iii. S6E2, Ludicrous that Azure Dragon NOT have sensors in ALL directions! Its intercept scene is worse!
- 2. **Weapons**: Directed-energy weapons are minimal & lasers are mainly used in their inertial confinement fusion power.
 - a. **Percussion Guns** are still the standard used for personal combat, plus mini-rockets for powered armor.
 - b. Missiles (Torpedoes) are used on spacecraft of all sizes, up to interplanetary bombardment nukes.

- f. E6: **Rock Bottom**: Revelations, new beginnings, betrayals, sacrifice, & vengeance.
 - i. The lives and desperation of rock-hoppers (small-time asteroid miners).
 - ii. 1st instance of you-can-survive-exposure-to-vacuum in the show.
- g. E7: Windmills: the sometimes-it's-beneficial-to-NOT-kill-a-captured-spy-on-sight episode.

 - i. Hints at all the weird physics-breaking the Protomolecule is capable of, and more.
 - ii. Well-acted 2-second delay video-call between Chrisjen on Earth & Arjun on Luna.
 - iii. Perhaps the most weirdly wonderful romantic scene I've ever seen between 2 actors.

- 14. Book 9: Leviathan Falls, 2021
- 15. The Expanse Board Game: Medium difficulty, one "Doors and Corners" expansion, 2-4 players.
 - a. 2-player OPA vs Mars, 3-player adds Earth, 4-player adds Protogen, all with slightly different capabilities.
 - b. Vying for control of 16 bases, no dice, and no real combat between fleets in orbitals.
 - c. There's also a "The Expanse Role Playing Game", but I know very little about its details.
 - d. <u>Nebulous: Fleet Command If The EXPANSE Was A Space Game</u> this video shows this is the closest to The Expanse's space combat of any online game I've seen, even though they have unrealistic ship speed Limits!
 - e. The Expanse Gameplay Reveal | gamescom ONL 2022/08/23 Clip from Drummer's POV for RPG coming in '23.
- 16. Other Reading and Viewing:
 - a. <u>Belgian Mary</u> watching 1st episode of **The Expanse** & becoming an instant fan.
 - b. Kim Stanley Robinson's Mars Trilogy of books is considered by some to be a The Expanse's Mars Prequel.
 - c. Liu Cixin's Three-Body Problem trilogy is amazing, from a cultural, story-line, & writing-style perspective!

- i. I DON'T recommend watching the 2023 Chinese Three-Body since it's faster to read the books!
- ii. I do recommend the 2023 U.S. 3 Body Problem, since it captures most of the 1st book's intent.
- d. Adrian Tchaikovsky's Children of Time & Children of Ruin, are both truly extraordinary hard-science fiction!
- e. The Peripheral, is stunning, fascinating, & well-worth your viewing time, but 2023 SAG-AFTRA strike killed it.
- f. For All Mankind: Soviets land man on Moon 1st & altered history after that (OK Space-related Soap Opera).
- g. Star Trek: Strange New Worlds: has reclaimed The Original's vibe, does some wacky stuff, but so did TOS!
- h. **Foundation**: If you love Asimov's excellent books, then you'll be really let-down by this weak visual series.
- i. Lost In Space, surprisingly entertaining, but it's not in the same league as The Expanse.

The Expanse, Drive, a very short story getting "standalone ebook publication within Memory's Legion on 2022/03/15."

- 1. Books grab reader's attention differently that screen adaptations, so this story starts with dramatic acceleration rather than a visual preamble of where and when the scene is.
 - BTW, there is NO reference to the specific year & no "137 years earlier" statement.
- 2. Solomon Epstein's yacht had his fuel reserve at 90% at start of test.
- 3. Ten minutes into burn the fuel was at 89.6%.
- 4. Every 2 minutes the fuel reserve goes down another 0.1%.
- 5. Solomon's mental calculation is after all fuel used in 37 hours the yacht will be at about 5% C.
- 6. Solomon met his future wife (Caitlin Esquibel) ten years earlier, at 1 of 4 real pubs there. (5th one non-alcoholic.)
 - o Solomon was working at Dhanbad Nova research center then.
- 7. Epstein Drive invented 3 generations after 1st Martian colonists arrived.
 - o Which was 11 years after one of Solomon's friends stated Mars was self-sufficient.
 - o Solomon was an "Engine Engineer" for "Masstech" corporation.

- Engine's Thrust to Weight Ratio: Presumably over 3 (The *Roci* has a dry TWR of 2.6)

- Fusion pulse rate: "can be achieved with as few as 10 pulses per sec, or hundreds if possible" Latter estimate would give a fully-fuelled Nauvoo with a Dv of 0.24c a mass ratio of around 34.
